## **Responsibilities Include:**

- 1. Create a program with detailed timelines that satisfies the requirements of CKC Canoe Kids Program. Develop routines, schedules, and procedures for camp operation.
- 2. Assist in the selection of staff and volunteers.
- 3. Prepare and conduct pre-camp and in-service staff trainings. Assign staff activities and other responsibilities.
- 4. Act as a leader and a role model for staff, volunteers and campers.
- 5. Create an Emergency Action Plan and familiarize staff.
- 6. Be familiar with the "Safe Boating Guide" and ensure that all staff and participants abide by the rules and regulations set out by the Canadian Coast Guard at all times.
- 7. Ensure all equipment is in safe, working order and report any damages.
- 8. Ensure the Sudbury Canoe Club property including docks are clean and safe for use.
- 9. Request orders of necessary supplies and equipment.
- 10. Maintain ongoing communication with parents.
- 11. Maintain ongoing communication with management.
- 12. Monitor safety and all procedures as they pertain to the complete supervision of all campers and staff.
- 13. Help provide an atmosphere for developing good morale and well-being among the staff, volunteers and campers.
- 14. Prepare an evaluation and summary of current season including inventories, staff evaluations, camper reports, and recommendations for the following season.
