

Policy on Personal Flotation Device

Sudbury Canoe Club 206 Ramsey Lake Road Sudbury, Ontario

Transport Canada regulations dictate that any canoe, kayak, stand up paddleboard (SUP), racing canoe/kayak, white water kayak, dragon boat must carry a Personal Flotation Device (PFD), a bailer, a heaving line (15 metres long), and a signaling device such as a whistle. If paddling before sun up or after sundown navigational lights are required.

The Sudbury Canoe Club assumes no responsibility for providing the above mentioned equipment or for ensuring its members abide by these carriage requirements.

It is the Policy of the Sudbury Canoe Club **that all members, guests and athletes are required to wear a PFD when using Club equipment**. While the Club provides the necessary equipment, it is the responsibility of the member and guests to ensure that they meet the required regulations.
